

Support animal reasonable accommodation Policy

The authority to review, approve, and to deny requests for reasonable accommodations under the fair housing act is to be delegated to the President of the Association, provided the President consult with the Association's attorney prior to making a decision. The President may also, in his or her discretion, call for a special board meeting to approve or deny the request. All information obtained from reasonable accommodation requests must be kept confidential and will not be available for review by owners.
